

WRFHA Jersey Policy

- 1.1 Parents will review and acknowledge receipt of this policy at registration.
- 1.2 Team Managers will record the jersey numbers assigned to each player and the condition of the jerseys when handed out and submit this list to the WRFHA Equipment Manager.
- 1.3 Jerseys ARE NOT to be left in gear bags after use. The use of a Jersey/ Garment bag is highly recommended.
- 1.4 Jerseys are not to be worn during practice.
- 1.5 Name Bars and A's or C's must be HAND SEWN on, NOT IRONED or GLUED. (Tight Machine sewing will damage the jersey.)
- 1.6 Jerseys are not to be signed or affixed with any other items unless approved by WRFHA.
- 1.7 Jersey's are to be washed in cold water and hung to dry. Do not put Jerseys in a dryer.
- 1.8 Name Bars and A's or C's must be removed from the Jersey prior to being returned.
- 1.9 At the completion of the season, jerseys are to be washed and promptly returned to the Coach/Manager who will return them to the WRFHA Equipment Manager as a team set.
- 2.0 Any jersey not returned by April 30th or showing signs of abuse (other than normal wear) will be charged to the player at \$100 per jersey. If not paid before the following season, the above fee (per player) will be added to the player's registration the following year. (No Player will be considered Registered until the jersey fee is paid)
